The Chippewa County 4-H shooting programs that are promoted by the Bloomer Rod and Gun Club are a major project. Only about 10 years ago there were only 20 youth involved in the shooting programs. This year there were 150 kids learning about safety and shooting archery, air rifles, and air pistols. Archery in the schools and support from Bloomer Rod and Gun; Lions Sportsmen's Club; and White Tails Unlimited have done a lot to advance the local programs.
