There are some rules that MUST be followed to participate in the events. Tentative dates for practice matches are May 17, June 14, and July 12 starting at 1 p.m. The State match will be August 7 and 8. August 7 we will be for setting up at 3 p.m. Those that will be running the event Saturday will shoot their scores on the 7<sup>th</sup>. On August 8, signups start at 8 a.m. and shooting starts as soon as enough have signed up to start a group. Prize drawings will be done around 1 p.m.
