SHOOT ONLY AT PAPER TARGETS PLACED INSIDE OF BUNKER

CLEAN UP YOUR TARGETS AND BRASS

SHOOT ONLY FROM INSIDE SHOOTING HOUSE

NO VEHICLES DOWNRANGE

NO UNCONTROLLED RAPID FIRE

CALL “CEASEFIRE” TO CHECK TARGETS—OPEN ACTION ON GUN, STEP AWAY FROM FIREARM

NO LARGE CALIBER SHOOTING AT 25-YARD RANGE

FULLY AUTOMATIC FIRE AND ACTUATOR-TYPE DEVICES ARE PROHIBITED

TRACER, ARMOR PIERCING AND INCENDIARY AMMUNITION AND 50 CALIBRE BMG OR LARGER ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED

ANY VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN REVOCATION OF PRIVILEGES AND DISMISSAL OF MEMBERSHIP
